Dear Non-Custodial Parent:

Effective September 1, 2007, a law was passed which requires that employers withhold child support arrearage payments from employee lump sum payments.

Texas law requires an employer who receives a withholding order from the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) to notify the OAG to determine how much should be withheld for child support arrearages prior to making a lump-sum payment in the amount of \$500 or more to that employee. [Texas Family Code §158.215]

Your employer has notified our office that you are eligible to receive a lump sum payment over \$500. Our office has confirmed that an arrearage amount exists on your child support case. Your employer has been instructed to withhold 50% of the net lump sum payment or the total amount of arrearage owed, whichever amount is less. This withheld amount will be applied to your arrearage balance.
